Shekhar Pathak taught in Kumaon University at Nainital; had been Fellow of IAS, Shimla and NMML, New Delhi.

He has worked on Himalayan history, culture, languages, folklore, social movements, freedom struggle, personalities, out-migration, Himalayan explorations. His works on coolie begar system, forest movements, and definitive biography of Pundit Nain Singh Rawat are well known. He is associated with People's Linguistic Survey of India (PLSI) and People's Association for Himalaya Area Research and edits the journal PAHAR.

He has been travelling in Himalaya-Tibet for the last 40 years. To mention a few are his three journeys to Mt. Kailas and Lake Manasarovar, four journeys to four sides of Mt. Chomolangma/Mt. Everest (Nepal, Sikkim and Tibet), Five Askot Arakot Abhiyans (1974-2014) from eastern corner of Uttarakhand to its western border and many journeys on the foot prints of Web and Raper (1808), Pundit Nain Singh Rawat and Rahul Sankrityayan. He has published a few books, research papers and popular articles; edited 20 volumes of Pahar. Among his recent books are 'Hari Bhari Ummeed', 'Dastaan-I-Himalaya' and 'Chipko Movement: A People's History'.
